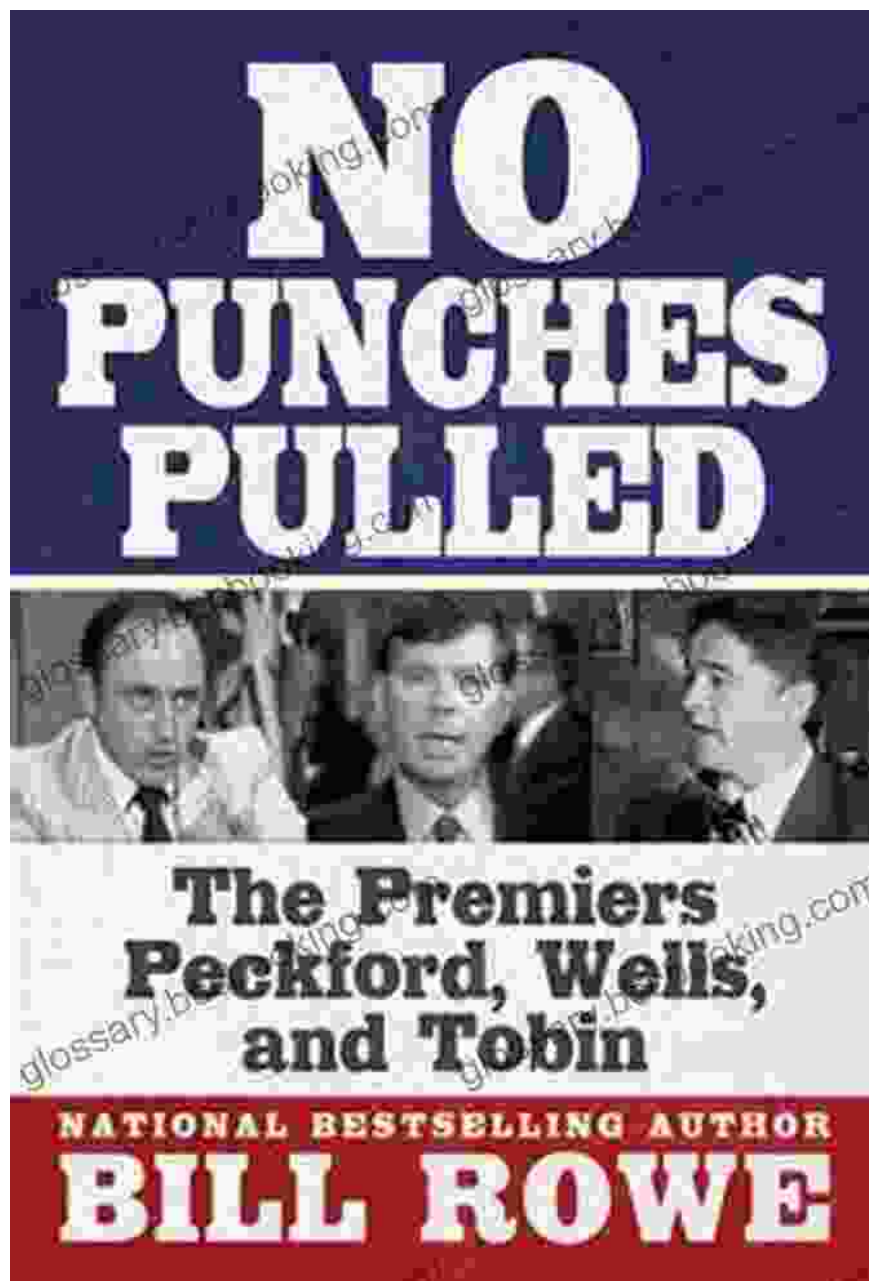
Brian Peckford

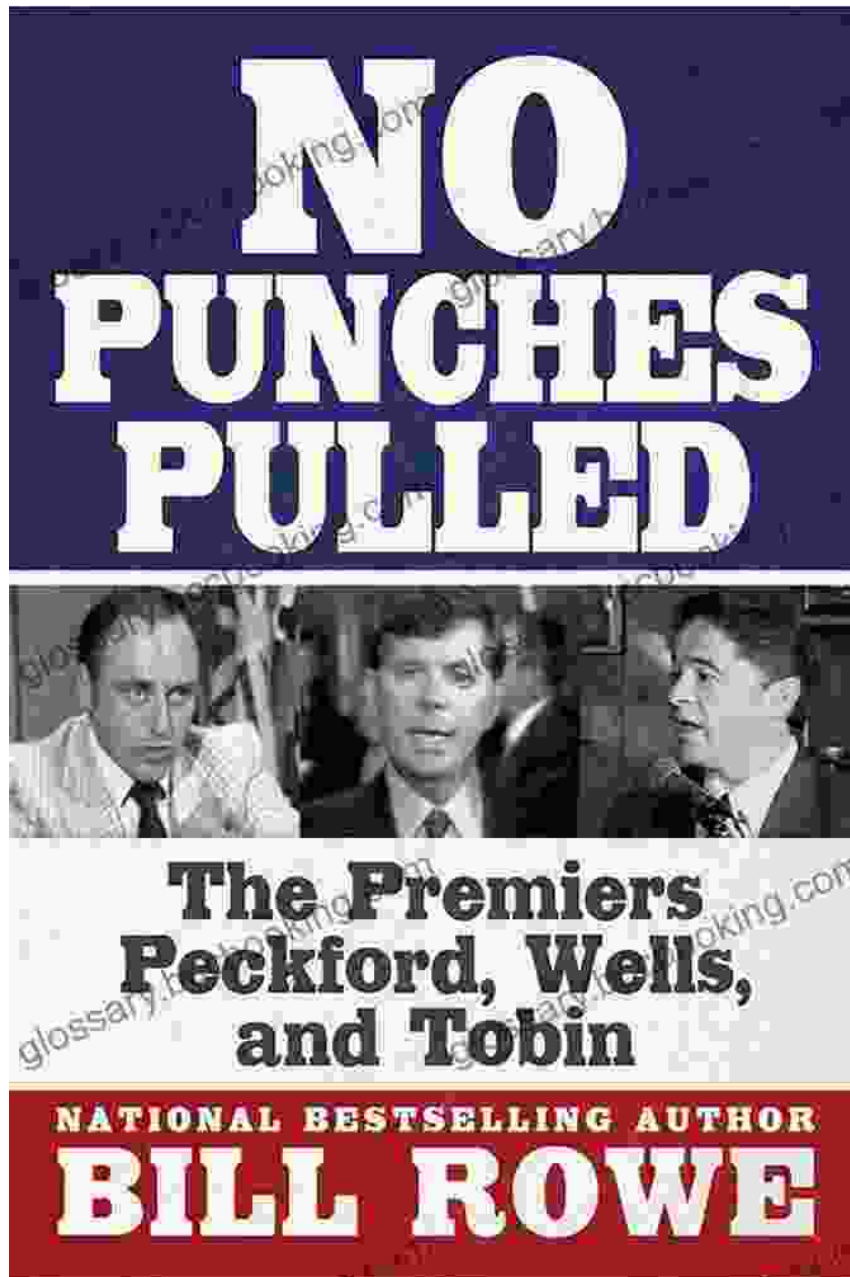

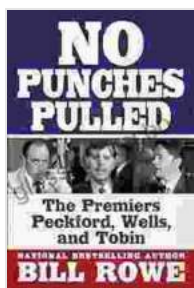

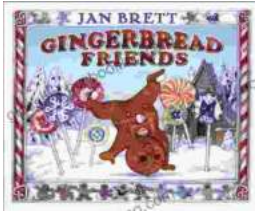
